

Visitors to studio one at Commonplace [CPAP] are invited to take on a character and play their part in a virtual world constructed from ordinary objects that have been dismantled and re-jigged in interesting and amusing ways

Participants are invited to take part in Timoney's interactive performances at CPAP during the month of June. Each informal performance will last up to two hours and times and dates are as follows:

Saturdays 14th 21st 28th June 2008 [one afternoon open performance each date from 2pm]

Paul has worked on a number of successful projects that have involved open and invited participation. These include SHOW at The Excursions Festival 2008 in Limerick and BIG MASSIVE PROTEST at Out Of Site 2006 in Dublin and Project 06 in Galway.

CPAP info...

Allowing artists time and space to articulate their interests in an environment conducive to an expansion beyond the assumed understanding of amateurism, space to work and productive behaviour.

Commonplace Amateur Projects is a multiple-use project space located in Dublin's City centre. Founded by artist Sally Timmons in her studio at Commonplace, CPAP has three areas of programming including a city centre meeting or workspace available through a booking system, regular workshops and projects [commissioning programme of editioned works by artists]. CPAP began its programme of commissioning editioned artworks in September 2007 including three solo projects by artists Karl Burke [Irl], Andrew Salomone [US] and Paul Timoney [Irl] and a group project titled 'Take me back to Trinidad' that involved commissioning editioned artworks by twelve contemporary artists based in Ireland. Future projects during 2008 will include Sarah Browne [Irl] and Projector Collective [Irl].

Artists and curators visiting Dublin are encouraged to use CPAP as a cultural base for meetings or projects while spending time in the city.
